Prof. Cho received his B.S. in nuclear engineering from Seoul National University and Ph.D. in Nuclear Engineering from University of California at Berkeley. He worked at Science Applications, Inc in Palo Alto from 1980 to 1982, and at Brookhaven National Laboratory in Long Island from 1983 to 1987. In 1987, he joined the faculty at KAIST in Korea, mostly involved in reactor physics and transport theory and computation.

He is Fellow of American Nuclear Society, and Associate Editor of Nuclear Science and Engineering. He was the Technical Program Chair for the PHYSOR 2002, a series of the ANS topical meetings on reactor physics, held in Seoul, Korea. Currently, he serves as President of Korean Nuclear Society.
